National Federations are requested to inform the Judo Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina whether they will participate in the tournament or not by prescribed entry form not later than **February 15th 2010**.

Each federation will have to send to the Judo federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina the very precise composition of its delegation (enclosed form) by **March 22nd 2010**. No limit of participants per category.

Entry fee	National judo federations have to pay entry fee 30 € for each competitor. Payable to the Organizing Committee.
Transfer	Federations which reserve rooms in the official hotels of competition can make use of all transportation. They will be picked up at the airport or train station and after competition transferred back to the airport or train station. Federation not staying in official hotels can't use transportation.
Liability	Neither the organisers of the event, nor the Judo Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (nor any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to your property arising out of your participation and travelling in connection with this tournament. The Judo Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina declines all responsibility.
Judogis	Please note, that blue and white judogis will be obligatory.
Visa	For nations, who need VISA to enter Bosnia and Herzegovina, please send to us as soon as possible (latest 1st March 2010) the list of participants with names, passport numbers, birth dates and function.

Back Number

1. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official back number made up of two parts: the FIXED upper part, consisting of the Surname and the National Olympic Abbreviation; the CHANGEABLE bottom part consisting of the event name and the sponsors, unique for each event.
2. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the FIXED part of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com. Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.
3. The CHANGEABLE part will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.
